We are following Year 1 Maths and English for **week 3 (not week 4)**, Foundation subjects: either offline which means an activity I'm suggesting or the lesson indicated also to be found at the National academy. Remember to read as much as you can: there are lots of books on Oxford Owl (see class handout).

	Maths	English	Other (pm)
Monday	Recognise, read and write numbers to 100	Hear a story	Science: Draw a tree in spring. How do you know that it is spring?
Tuesday	Explore components of numbers within 100	To commit a story to memory	Art: sort a set of coloured pencils/pens into colours that make you happy and colours that make you sad. Using the happy colours draw a happy.
Wednesday	Explore components of numbers within 100	Identify features of a character's appearance	Phonics Play online (see class handout): Play any game using sounds from Phase 4/5.
Thursday	Apply knowledge of number bonds	Identify features of a character's personality	Art: Using your pens/pencils from Tuesday draw yourself using happy colours and yourself using sad colours.
Friday	To one more or one fewer, and ten more or ten fewer	To write a character description	Science: whilst on your daily walk can you spot any wild plants. Can you name them? Or can you count how many dandelions or daisies that you see?
